Stephen Weller made his professional debut as Enjolras in Les Misérables, before going on to play the title role in Martin Guerre (UK tour and cast recording). Other theatre work includes Jerry Springer: The Opera; Woman in White; The Producers; 42nd Street; Raoul in Ken Hill's Phantom of the Opera; and Harry & Young Ebenezer/Scrooge as well as pantomime. He frequently appears as a West End Guest Artist for Disney Cruise Line.

Stephen has performed in numerous concerts including Showtime at the Stadium, Sondheim Tonight, Salute to the Stars and ABBA Symphonica. He has toured the UK in You Don't Bring Me Flowers, a show dedicated to the songs of Neil Diamond and Barbra Streisand, and toured Europe with Gregorian – Masters of Chant. As well as extensive work as a Capital Voices soloist and a session singer (Maida Vale Singers and Metro Voices), Stephen has appeared as a backing vocalist for performers including Michael Crawford, Russell Watson, Martine McCutcheon, Michael Ball and Elaine Paige.

Stephen works with the vocal cabaret groups The Masters of the House and The WestEnders, appearing on the WestEnders' album Hear The People Sing. Other recordings include soundtracks for The Phantom of the Opera, Sweeney Todd, The 300, Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, Into the Woods and Kung Fu Panda.
